Junior Sailing Instructor

Reports To

The Junior Sailing Instructors will report to the Head Sailing Instructor.

Job Overview

Your primary duty will be as a sailing instructor for 7-18 year old children and teens. In addition, we expect you to work cooperatively with the entire staff of the Milford Yacht Club in maintaining a SAFE, WELL-ORDERED, and FUN-FILLED sailing environment for your sailing students both on the water and ashore.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Provide for the safety of the sailing students.
- Develop sportsmanship, seamanship, integrity, and interpersonal skills.
- Create a fun atmosphere for sailors of all levels and interests.
- Instill responsibility for boats, equipment, and facilities.
- Provide high quality instruction that is tailored to the individual sailor's needs.
- Communicate well with parents regarding each sailor's progress.

Qualifications

All Jr Sailing Instructors must have experience either sailing and racing or coaching Optimists and 1 other boat class – 420, Laser, or RS Feva.

As a condition of employment, provide copies of:

- Current US Sailing Small Boat Sailing Level 1 certificate
- Safe Powerboat Handling Certificate
- Current First Aid and CPR certificates
- Connecticut Safe Boating Certificate

You must demonstrate proficiency in operating small powerboats. A safety checkout will be performed in the Club's safety boats.

You will be employed for eight weeks starting in late June and ending mid-August. The salary is based on a 40 hour work week. You may be required to accompany junior sailors to regattas and in these instances your hours may vary. Hours worked for time outside the normal day and beyond your standard 40 hour week, i.e. weekend regattas, evening activities (exclusive of the year end banquet), etc. will be paid in addition to the weekly salary.
